Dear Sir,

This is further to the Pre Bid Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2008 in the office of PNGRB on the above subject. In this connection following may be treated as part of the Document. This supersedes the relevant provision in the said document.

1. The criterion of Turnover has been reduced to Rs. 300 Crs. and Net Profit criterion to Rs. 30 Crs. of the value.
2. The time period for completion of assignment has been increased as given below:

3. The last date for submission of bid has been extended to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2008 from 30<sup>th</sup> May 2008. Consequently, the bids should reach PNBRRB office latest by 2.30 pm of 9<sup>th</sup> June 2008 and the unprice bid shall be opened at 3.30 pm of 9<sup>th</sup> June 2008 at PNGRB.

Bidders are advised to quote strictly as per the terms and conditions of the tender document and not to stipulate any deviations/exceptions. Once quoted, the bidder shall not make price changes after due date and time submission of the bid, even if any deviation or exception may be specifically stated in the bid. Price changes through any other mode also shall render the offer liable for rejection. PNGRB reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids received at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason whatsoever.

All other conditions/eligibility criteria of the tender remain the same.
