NOTICE INVITING TENDER for Computerisation of various activities

Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board intends to select part(ies) for Computerisation of various activities of the board and its function as stipulated in the PNGRB Act, 2006.

The bids are invited from the interested parties operating in India, including the foreign firms having their registered offices in India. The vendors are invited to submit Technical and Financial bids for the above-mentioned activity separately.

The Tender Document consisting of scope of work and other relevant details, Instruction to Bidders and format for submission of proposals can be obtained from the Office of the PNGRB at the address given above on payment of non refundable fee of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft/Pay order drawn on any Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank in favor of Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board, payable at New Delhi between 11.00 to 16.00 Hrs. on all working days except for the due date of opening of tender. Cheques /Money orders shall not be accepted. Tender documents can also be obtained by post by sending an application to the undersigned alongwith an extra amount of Rs.500/- towards postal charges. However, PNGRB shall not be held responsible for any postal delay if tender document is demanded/ submitted by post. The tender document could also be downloaded from the website www.pngrb.gov.in. However, bids of only those entities shall be opened whose payment has been received in the Board before the due date.

The RFP/tender document can be purchased from 19th June to 9th July 2008. Date for submission of bids is 10th July 2008 by 1430 hours and date of opening of technical bids is fixed on 10th July 2008 at 1530 hours. Financial bids shall be opened at a later date, which shall be communicated to the short listed bidders.
