Further to the clarifications issued vide PNGRB's letter of even number dated 29th May, 2012 related to the bids invited for development of Rewari-Kanpur Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipeline, the following additional clarifications are being issued based on the queries received pertaining to the bids invited for development of Awa-Salawas Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipeline:

S/N	Query received pertaining to Awa-Salawas Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipeline	Clarification pertinent to Rewari-Kanpur Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipeline also
1	As per clause 1.1 & 17.2.2 of the application-cum-bid document, the system capacity of at least 0.6 MMTPA during the entire economic life has been mentioned to be created. Clause 5(b)(viii)(d) of G.S.R. 476 (E) stipulates "The annual capacity of pipeline system and sections shall be as per the operating days specified in the Access Code for respective systems". Access code is yet to be notified. HPCL will consider total hours in a year minus the planned maintenance hours in a year as notified in draft for establishing system capacity. PNGRB to please confirm	<i>Proposed draft Regulations on the Access Code for petroleum and petroleum products pipeline being formulated by the sub-committee constituted by PNGRB. However, in order to bring all bidders on the same platform, the planned maintenance period of ten days in case of petroleum and petroleum products pipeline shall be assumed by the bidders.</i>
2	As per clause 6(c) & 6(d) of the application-cum-bid document, the combined net worth of the entity along with its promoters to be considered for qualification for any bid shall be assessed in line with the clause (e) of sub-regulation	<i>In clause no. 6.0(c) & 6.0(d) of the application-cum-bid document, "clause (e)" may now be read as "clause (d)".</i>

6 to regulation 5 and the combined net worth shall be in line with Regulation 5(6)(e). While as per G.S.R. 722(E), combined net worth is mentioned under clause 5(6)(d) and hence HPCL shall submit combined net worth as per clause 5(6)(d).	
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The above clarifications shall constitute a part of the Application-Cum-Bid Document and shall be duly signed and submitted along with the bid document by the authorized signatory of the bidder.
